We have continued to support our members, local business and our community with value added services that are benefiting to our shared interest.

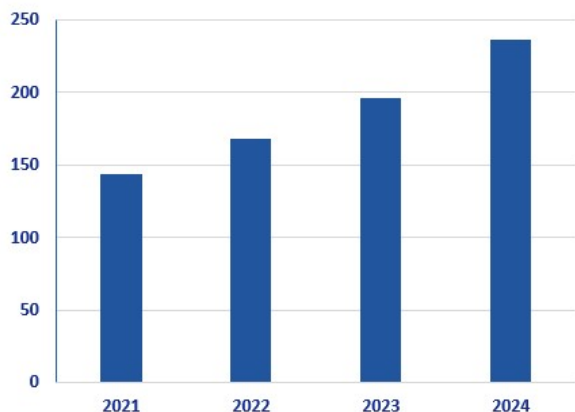

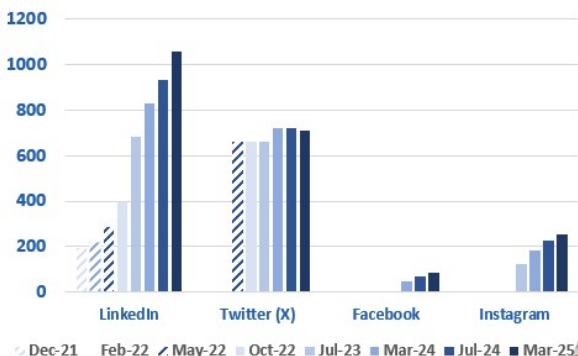

## Finance Report

The AGM concluded with a brief overview of the association's accounts from BHBPA's Finance Director James Jarman.

*"During the financial year ended 31 December 2024 the association made a loss of £16,280 which was mainly because of the decision to invest some of the accumulated reserves into an extra special event to celebrate the 20th anniversary of the association at the BHBiz Awards 2024 held at the Amex Stadium.*

*The total net cost of this event was just over £13,000 and was seen as a way to reward existing members, to aid the association in member retention as well as driving interest and future growth in its membership.*

*Cash held remained healthy at £45,088 as at the end of December 2024 with total reserves holding above £40,000."*

## Our Guest Speaker - Jane Davey - Chair of the Governors of Burgess Hill Academy

Jane explained why Community Partnerships are so important for the school

She explained the issues faced by the school recently and the recent favourable OFSTED reports that show how the school has been turned around. It's in an upward trajectory, but it's part of a journey.

They're empowering all stakeholders in school decisions and sharing voice among parents, students, staff and community partners

These students are the future for the town – we want them to have the highest expectations of themselves and know that they can add value to their community.

### By raising the profile of the school, we raise the profile of Burgess Hill

The community is being brought into the classroom through real World learning and experience. Learning opportunities are being expanded and enriched through after-school, weekend, and summer programmes. A culture of belonging, safety, and care that inspires trust and a sense of community is being fostered.

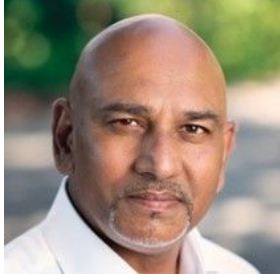

## Does Copilot Learn Over Time?

**Does Copilot learn over time? Your Microsoft 365 Copilot questions answered.**

Artificial intelligence (AI) has become a crucial technology, with companies eager to integrate it into their operations. Microsoft Copilot for 365 is a powerful assistant that can meet various business needs. This article addresses common questions about Copilot.



### **How Does Copilot Work?**

Copilot operates by generating answers based on prompts. It uses a complex training process to ensure responses are accurate and helpful. Copilot learns from its training data and uses this knowledge to solve problems, producing human-like responses.

- It can only generate text based on accessible data.
- Responses can sometimes be factually incorrect or repetitive.
- Due to its large dataset, Copilot can exhibit biases.
- It has file size, word, and thread size limitations within Microsoft 365.
- Its search capabilities are restricted to specific places.

### **Can Copilot Be Customised for Specific Business Needs?**

Yes, Copilot can be tailored to specific business requirements. Copilot Studio allows for the design, development, and deployment of custom AI copilots. Custom agents are another way to personalise Copilot.

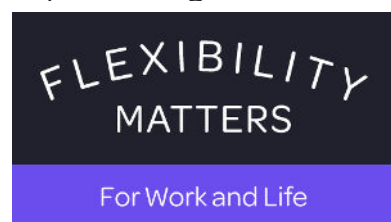
